Messrs. Shoemaker, Davey and Sylvain met with Mr. Robinson, M.P. and the Executive Assistant to Mr. Nunziata, M.P. (Opposition Critics for the Ministry of the Solicitor General) on June 18, 1986, prior to a Statement on Motions later that day by Mr. Beatty announcing the new SPUR initiative.

During the briefing, which took place in the Deputy Solicitor General's Boardroom, Mr. Shoemaker referred to the matters raised in Mr. Robinson's letter to Mr. Beatty of May 26, 1986 and indicated the following:

- (i) It would be inconsistent with the new SPUR policy to ask an applicant for a security clearance questions of the type identified in section 12 of the noted RCMP form.
- (ii) The Treasury Board would be responsible for developing new forms for government use which ensured consistency with the revised administrative security policies approved by the Government.
