Recently I received correspondence from [redacted] currently based in Inuvik, Northwest Territories. [redacted] has been employed as a member of the RCMP since [redacted] and has an outstanding record of service.

Following her recent posting to Inuvik, together with her partner [redacted] [redacted] sought the appropriate benefits for relocation. She was denied these benefits even though she is involved in a well established, loving relationship. As a result she has filed a grievance with the RCMP. Nevertheless it is clear that this is a broad policy question affecting all members of the RCMP. I would therefore ask that you ensure that the relevant regulations are amended to prevent this clear discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation. I enclose relevant background material for your information.
