1. At approximately 1400 hours, 30 Apr 57, a telephone message was received from Lt [redacted] of [redacted] to the effect that [redacted] is suspect of [redacted].
2. At approximately 1800 hours, 30 Apr 57, [redacted] was interviewed and he stated that at about 0800 hours, 30 Apr 57, whilst sleeping in his bed in building 406, [redacted] he woke up and found a male person lying on top of him. [redacted] further stated that at the time he woke up, this male person's penis was in between his legs in the area of his rectum. [redacted]'s statement is attached to this report as appendix "A".
3. At approximately 1830 hours, 30 Apr 57, [redacted] was interviewed and he admitted that he had been in bed with [redacted]. [redacted] declined to give a written statement.
4. [redacted] was placed under close arrest and was lodged in the [redacted] barracks pending further investigation.
5. At approximately 1815 hours, 1 Apr 57, [redacted] [redacted] was interviewed and he stated that at about 0400 hours, 30 Apr 57, whilst sleeping in his bed in building 406, [redacted] he woke up and found [redacted] under his blanket and on top of him. [redacted] further stated that at the time he woke up, [redacted] was trying to kiss him and was calling him [redacted]. A copy of [redacted] statement is attached to this report as appendix "B".
6. In view of the foregoing, this file will be kept open pending further investigation.
