C34.00/04-HOMOSEXUALITY-INVESTIGATION

(1) Immediately that any person subject to the Code of Service Discipline becomes aware that an act of a homosexual nature has taken place which involves serving personnel, dependents, or civilian employees, he shall report the matter to the SMO. If the SMO is of the opinion that further investigation is required at this stage, he shall undertake an inquiry himself or request other Service investigating agencies to investigate but, in any case, the investigation shall only extend to ascertain whether the report is an idle rumour or whether any substantiating evidence exists.

(2) If the SMO is of the opinion that substantiating evidence exists, he shall report the matter immediately to the CO.

(3) On receipt of the SMO's report (para (2)) the CO shall take the appropriate action as prescribed by C34.00/02.
