1 At 0015 hours 9 Aug 59 the writer was called by  
C0618 LAC Michael LATHAN, AFPM, to investigate an allegation  
of indecent assault. The writer attended the Air Force Police  
office and interviewed the subjects, [redacted]  
and [redacted] both Am/s  
stationed at #6 Repair Depot.

2 As a result of this interview the following facts  
were obtained. At 2345 hours 8 Aug 59 the Orderly Officer,  
Pers/Adm, entered the Cpl's  
Club of this unit to collect the bar receipts. While so  
engaged [redacted] approached him and asked that the Air  
Force Police be called. When asked why, [redacted] said that  
one of the Corporals was a 'fruit' and had been 'touching him  
up' during the evening. As [redacted] appeared to be drunk the  
OO said he would attend to the complaint as soon as all the  
bar receipts had been collected. [redacted] refused to wait  
saying that he would do something and then he ([redacted])  
would have to call the Police. [redacted] turned his back  
and [redacted] picked up a bottle which he threw against the  
mirror behind the bar. This broke a small glass but did not  
harm the mirror. [redacted] then called the AF.  
[redacted] attended and [redacted] pointed out [redacted] as the person  
who had made the indecent advances to him. Both subjects  
were taken to the Air Force Police Office.

3 At 0030 hours 9 Aug 59 the writer interviewed  
[redacted] in the presence and hearing of [redacted] and [redacted].  
[redacted] stated that he and [redacted] worked in the  
same section and on several occasions had been out drinking  
together. On returning from their drinking bouts they  
would either go to his or to [redacted] room and masturbate.  
On a dance night in early June, [redacted] was unable to recall  
the date, they slept in the same bed in [redacted] room. On  
this occasion [redacted] tried to carnally know [redacted]'s  
anus. [redacted] offered no resistance. On Saturday 8 Aug 59  
they decided to go into the Royal Hotel in Trenton, but be-  
fore leaving they masturbated. Both men spent the afternoon  
drinking returning to their unit at about 1600 hours. [redacted]  
went into the Cpl's Mess and continued drinking. [redacted]  
went to his room stripped and got into bed naked.  
He awoke at about 1700 hours, with his penis erect and [redacted]  
rubbing it with his hands. He removed [redacted]  
hands and masturbated, the semen ejaculated was placed in  
a handkerchief and stuffed behind the bed. Although [redacted]  
watched the proceedings he [redacted] did not  
masturbate at this time. Both men left [redacted] and came to the  
Cpl's Club on this unit. [redacted] During the course of the  
evening, had too much to drink, he felt that in this con-  
dition [redacted] would try and sleep with him. While he  
did not mind [redacted] touching his private parts, he  
thought that if [redacted] carnally knew his anus he would  
turn into a pervert. [redacted] states that he masturbates at  
least once a week, and he wanted this matter brought to light  
so as to be cured. Although [redacted] appeared to be drunk  
he was also highly agitated and nervous.

ASSAULTS - Sex Offences  
Air Force Police

4 The writer then interviewed [redacted], the complaint was outlined to him and he strongly denied each and every part of it. He was cautioned in accordance with QR(Air) 101.06 and invited to reply. His story was the same as given by [redacted] in Para 3 except that he denied any indecent actions. [redacted] had been drinking but his speech was not slurred and he was coherent. His attitude was most trucklent.

5 In accordance with AFAC 034.00/47 the writer contacted the EDO at ERD, 232817 F/L LO PINGEL, Tech/A, and the Duty Medical Officer, 52736 F/L Kenneth WALKER, Med/MO. The facts in this occurrence were outlined to them and on the direction of F/L Pingel both subjects were placed under 'Open Arrest'. F/L Walker stated that he would investigate the matter on Monday 10 Aug 59. The writer and [redacted] went to the rooms occupied by these men and recovered two handkerchieves containing what appears to be seminal stains. These were brought to the AFP office and treated with ultra-violet light, the result was positive. These handkerchieves were placed in a container and identified should they be required for further tests.

6 As both of these men are ERD personnel the exhibits with a copy of this report have been handed over to the Air Force Police of that unit. A copy of this report has been sent to the Commanding Officer of #6 Repair Depot.
