NEXT FINAL

1 While conducting an investigation ref AUSA-7-99 on 18 Sep 59, the writer in company of Cpl EW ERNST, AFPM, were in the company of Morality Officer BSEY, Ottawa City Police. During normal conversation he mentioned that he and another morality officer had observed two women driving down Rideau Street, Ottawa in a convertible. At each red traffic light the two women would fondly embrace and passionately kiss each other. Officer BSEY could not remember the date of this act.

2 On a pretext of a search for liquor the two officers ordered the driver of the car to stop. The driver he tentatively identified as _____, an airwoman stationed near Barbury, Ont. The officers did not find anything to warrant an arrest so they were allowed to go. The officers did not take the names of the women and could not remember the name of the second person.

3 A check of BEAF records reveals only one airwoman member by that name, is, _____, Rockport, presently stationed at Falconbridge, Ont.

4 A picture of the above named airwoman was obtained from CAFPS and shown to Morality Officer BSEY who stated that the picture certainly looked like the woman whom he had seen in the episode described above.

5 The writer is of the opinion that these actions could possibly place the subject airwoman into a category defined in Memorandum File reference CAC 1617-3 (CAC) dated 2 Jul 59 paragraph 7(i). It is respectfully submitted however that this does not necessarily indicate that she is so implied but rather this information is submitted as a source of information on which further investigation may be based.

6 Attached as Appendix "A" to this narrative is the photograph of the subject airwoman that Morality Officer BSEY identified as the woman who had been "looking" with the other woman in a convertible on Rideau Street, Ottawa.
