1. Adverting to previous reports submitted by [redacted] and [redacted] at [redacted] by further investigation of the alleged offence has been undertaken by SIU Ops.

2. The complainant, [redacted] was interviewed at [redacted] Station [redacted] by the undersigned on 7 Sep 60. His statement, obtained under caution, contains details of the acts of homosexuality allegedly committed with the subject and is attached as appendix [redacted].

3. Throughout the interrogation [redacted] insisted that he had never before had homosexual contacts and that his reason for doing so with [redacted] was based on his loneliness and want of companionship and the fact that [redacted] was an officer. [redacted] expressed concern over the contents of certain letters which he wrote to the subject officer and stated that he was afraid that if read by anyone ie; the investigators, they might give the wrong impression and someone [redacted] might get the idea that I am also a homosexual. [redacted] will be 31 years of age on [redacted] he is a clean cut, presentable airman who indicated that he wished to make the [redacted] his career. He stated that he has a normal interest in girls and claims to have been going "steady" with a girl in Toronto over the past two years. This relationship has been confined to exchange of letters and visits while [redacted] is on annual leave.

4. Because of airfield construction at RCAF Sta North Bay during September, 433 [redacted] has been diverted to 400 Units in the area. With the co-operation of the [redacted] of Sta North Bay it was arranged that [redacted] be diverted to [redacted] Uplands for duty during the period in question. [redacted] arrived at [redacted] Uplands during the week of 10th Sep. On 14 Sep the [redacted] of Sta Uplands, [redacted] was acquainted with the allegations concerning the subject officer. Full co-operation was extended the investigators throughout the enquiry. [redacted] search of the subject's room failed to reveal any letters or other evidence of value. [redacted] was then approached and made aware of the purpose of the interview. [redacted] freely admitted his part in the relationship with [redacted] and volunteered a statement which is attached as appendix [redacted].

5. During the interrogation [redacted] admitted that the homosexual acts committed by him with [redacted] "ervey" and [redacted] "ervey" consisted of mutual acts of oral copulation and masturbation. [redacted] declined to include any reference to oral copulation in his statement however. [redacted] was most emphatic that the homosexual acts between himself and [redacted] were confined to mutual masturbation and kissing only.

this officer is already on rehabilitation leave and refused
a permanent commission offered him in order to return to school.

Comox, BC.

8 [redacted] with respect to the allegations concerning [redacted]'s
contacts at North Bay, as related in the last paragraph of [redacted]'s
statement, the [redacted] referred to is no doubt [redacted]
was unable to identify the sirmen mentioned in the same paragraph
of [redacted] statement, however he offered the following description:

IAE or OIL, worked in the operations section,
medium height, fair, thinning hair, 24-25 yrs
old.

He went on to state that the party referred to in [redacted] statement
took place in late spring and was in the manner of a farewell party
for the sirmen referred to above and also [redacted] and [redacted].
It is possible that the sirmen described is [redacted],
Pfc [redacted] 3 who was transferred from North Bay to Duluth, Minn on 15
May 60.

9 [redacted] stated that he had frequent homosexual re-
lations ie; every couple of months whenever the opportunity presented
itself, with male persons. These contacts were usually with strangers
or acquaintances met in bars, taverns etc in different cities and
consisted of different acts of homosexuality ie; masturbation and
oral copulation. He indicated that since he was ten years old he
had had relationships with homosexuals.

10 G/C Musells was advised of [redacted]'s admissions on
the late afternoon of 14 Sep. The investigators were advised that
arrangements would be made to have [redacted] return to [redacted] Sta North
Bay on 15 Sep.

11 This investigation is considered concluded with the sub-
mission of this report, unless otherwise advised.
