In para (4) of the investigation summary attached to WSU Detachment Vancouver report W2300-3-60 dated 18 Nov 60, a request is made for confirmation of certain facts in connection with the absence of [redacted] subject of our file W2500-3-60. [redacted] was AWA from RCAF Station Holberg from 25 Sep 60 to 4 Oct 60 when he failed to return to his Unit on completion of annual leave.

2. Investigation in the above connection was conducted by the writer and Sgt Carpenter of this Unit. Because [redacted] was apprehended on the first day of the investigation, no notes were kept of the various places that he stayed while on leave in the Tofield District and during his subsequent absence. During the initial stages of the inquiry it was learned that [redacted] had worked for a farmer by the name of [redacted] who farms south and east of Tofield, and had lived at the farm during his period of employment. This information was obtained from the Postmaster in Tofield, who gave the impression that [redacted] had worked there for several weeks. Other information gained from independent witnesses interviewed, indicated that [redacted] had also stayed for a short period of time at the farm of his girl friend's father located north of Tofield. In conversation with [redacted] it was learned that [redacted] had also stayed at home a part of the time he was in the Tofield area, and it was also confirmed that he had actually stayed at the other two places mentioned. From this there would appear to be little doubt but that he was actually in the Tofield area the greater part of his leave period, and certainly during the period of his absence. The name [redacted] did not come up at any time during the course of this investigation. It is appreciated that [redacted] could have met [redacted] in Edmonton during the period of time involved, but if he did it could not have been for any great length of time.

3. It is extremely doubtful that inquiries in the Tofield area would result in any more specific information than what has been set out in this report, considering the time lapse involved and the fact that most persons interviewed originally were not able to provide positive dates.

4. It is considered that this information should satisfy the inquiry, considering the requirement, however if further details should be required then a patrol will be made to the Tofield area on request.

5. Per para (3) of WSU Detachment Vancouver Summary of Investigation, referred to in para (1) of this report, an investigation will be undertaken by this Unit to determine whether or not Mr. R. WOOD of 11045 - 85th Ave., Edmonton, is in fact associating with members of the RCAF, and if so in what way. Any information forthcoming will become subject of a report, and will be opened at that time under the appropriate file heading.
