1 Forwarded in duplicate is Stn Winnipeg's AF Police report TW200-2-61 dated 25 Sep 61 which deals with an "indecent assault" on a male person by the subject airman.

2 A review of this report indicates that the complainant, [redacted] called at the Guard House and reported that he had been indecently assaulted by [redacted]. As a result of a statement made by [redacted] appendix "A" to this report refers, [redacted] was interviewed and made a statement complaining about the actions of [redacted].

3 [redacted] was interviewed and at first denied all knowledge of the complaints made against him. After further questioning he admitted his responsibilities. [redacted] was subsequently handed over to the medical authorities at Fort Osborne Barracks.

4 A review of records at this branch indicate that while stationed at Stn Foymount, [redacted] was suspected to be of homosexual tendencies. ADCHQ Welfare Officer was advised of this incident, their file [redacted] refers.

5 This file has been referred to the SOMS and SOPA at this CHQ who advise that any further action in connection with [redacted] will be as a result of the psychiatric diagnosis and presume that release will be effected under CAFAO 34.00/54.
