DAFS has pointed out that the proposed amendment to AFAO C19.00/17 at Min (1) makes no provision for COs to refer female personnel for psychiatric examination. In discussion with PA2, it was agreed that psychiatric examination should be available for personnel of both sexes.

Accordingly it is proposed to amend AFAO Cl9.00/17 by altering para (2) and adding new paras (3) and (4) as follows:

Minute Form

The CO, with the assistance of the SMO, shall investigate the case to determine whether the report is an idle rumour or any substantiating evidence exists. If male personnel are involved and the investigation reveals evidence which tends to substantiate the report, the CO shall continue his investigation with the SMO and any investigating agencies available to the CO. The investigation shall be conducted in such a manner that the subject will be caused the minimum embarrassment.

- If female personnel are involved and the investigation reveals evidence which tends to substantiate the report, the CO shall refer the matter to the local SIU for investigation.
- If either male or female personnel are involved, the CO shall refer the subject for psychiatric examination on the advice of the SMO. COs shall ensure that psychiatric examination is completed as quickly as possible. ".

DAFS has expressed approval of the above.
