1. In the course of an investigation involving Assault Causing Bodily Harm, C Pro C report CG-205-2-65 dated 14 Apr 65 refers, certain allegations were made regarding homosexuality among members of 1 Med Coy, EBS Bn, CAMP BAGETOWN NB.

2. At 0340 hrs 8 Apr 65, while giving a statement regarding this assault, [redacted] RCASC, 1 Med Coy, EBS Bn, CAMP BAGETOWN NB, stated that on 27 Mar 65, while on the train enroute from MONTREAL PQ to CAMP BAGETOWN NB, he had been approached while in his roomette by [redacted] RCASC, 1 Med Coy, EBS Bn, CAMP BAGETOWN NB and SE 186103 [redacted] RCASC, PLCC, EBS Bn, CAMP BAGETOWN NB. [redacted] stated that [redacted] had asked him to perform an act of felatio on him. He said he refused this request. A copy of the statement obtained from [redacted] is attached to this report as Annex "A".

3. At 1545 hrs 12 Apr 65, SE 185191 [redacted] was interviewed and a written statement was taken, a copy of which is attached to this report as Annex "B". In his statement [redacted] said that before going on course to CAMP BORDEN Ont, he had heard from [redacted] that [redacted] had performed an act of felatio on him. Also that while on course, [redacted] had informed him that during basic training, [redacted] had been investigated for homosexuality but that nothing was proved. He said that coming back on the train from course, he and [redacted] thought they would find out. He said that he, [redacted] and [redacted] started playing strip poker to see how [redacted] would react. He said that [redacted] kissed his and [redacted] penis each time [redacted] lost a hand of cards. He stated that [redacted] said that they had better quit because the porter may be in anytime to make the bed. He said that he and [redacted] then went to the dining car where he met a girl and went with her to her room. He went on to say that after leaving the girl in her room, he went to [redacted] and [redacted] room where [redacted] let him in. He said that [redacted] told him that [redacted] had just performed an act of felatio on him. He said that [redacted] told [redacted] to perform the same act on him, which he did. He added that [redacted] asked him later how he knew he was queer and he told [redacted] that he had seen it on his documents, although he had not.

4. At 1345 hrs 12 Apr 65, [redacted] was interviewed and a written statement was taken, a copy of which is attached to this report as Annex "C". In his statement, [redacted] said that he and [redacted] were drinking in MONTREAL on 27 Mar 65, while returning from course at CAMP BORDEN Ont. He said that on the train, he and [redacted] shared the same room and [redacted] was just down the hall. He said that he, [redacted] and [redacted] had a few drinks of gin in [redacted] and [redacted] room while playing cards. At approximately 2145 hrs, he and [redacted] went to the club car while [redacted] stayed in the room to make up the beds. He said that after about half an hour, [redacted] came to the club car. At this time [redacted] was sitting with a girl. He went on to say that after the bar closed he went back to his room where he found [redacted] in the top bunk. When he entered the room [redacted] got out of the bunk. He said that he got undressed and got into bed, half passing out. He added that he woke up and found [redacted] performing an act of felatio on him. He told [redacted] to stop. Shortly after, [redacted] came to the door at which time [redacted] stated that he climbed into the top bunk. He said that [redacted] and [redacted] were together in the bottom bunk as he fell asleep.

5. At 1040 hrs 13 Apr 65, [redacted] RCASC, 1 Med Coy, EBS Bn, CAMP BAGETOWN NB, was interviewed and a written statement was obtained, a copy of which is attached to this report as Annex "D". In his statement, [redacted] said that on the evening of 24 Dec 64, he, [redacted] and [redacted] were drinking liquor in [redacted] and [redacted] room. He said that they were drinking from right after supper until close to midnight and that he had a 26 oz bottle of rye, [redacted] had a bottle of rum and [redacted] had a bottle of vodka. He said that just before midnight, [redacted] got into bed and [redacted] helped him back to his room as he was nearly flaked out from drinking too much. He said that [redacted] left the room after helping him to his bed. He said that he does not remember how he got into bed but the next thing he remembered was being awakened later on in the night, laying naked on the bed with the bed clothes pulled down to the foot of the bed. He stated that [redacted] was performing an act of felatio on him. He added that being still groggy from drink, he lay there and did not let on that he was awake. He said that after approximately five minutes, [redacted] finished performing the act and left the room, after covering him up with the bed clothes. He said there was no one else present in the room at this time except [redacted] and him. He then stated that he went back to sleep and tried to forget about the incident.

6. At 1610 hrs 14 Apr 65, [redacted] was re-interviewed regarding the allegations made against him. After being cautioned, a written statement was obtained from him, a copy of which is attached to this report as Annex "E". In his statement, [redacted] said that on the evening of 24 Dec 64, he, [redacted] and [redacted] had been drinking liquor in his room. He said that [redacted] was laying on his bed and [redacted] was passed out on another bed. He said that he had helped [redacted] back to his room and laid him on his bed face up. He did not attempt to undress [redacted] and does not remember seeing anyone else in the room at this time. He said that he then left the room, closing the door behind him and went back to his own room. He went on to say that after approximately five minutes, he and [redacted] went to Pte [redacted] room to check on him. He saw [redacted] in bed with the bed clothes over him and his clothes in a pile on the floor beside his bed. They left the room and closed the door behind them, and went back to their own room. He said that [redacted] then went to bed and he went downstairs to watch TV, but did not notice if there was anyone else in the TV lounge. He said that he must have passed out as the next thing he remembered is coming to in the TV lounge. He did not know what time it was but noted that it was still dark. He added that he then went upstairs to bed after turning off the TV. He went on to say that he was playing strip poker with [redacted] and [redacted] in his roomette on the train on 27 Mar 65. He said that the strip poker was on the suggestion of [redacted] and that he went along with the suggestion as he was scared of [redacted]. He suggested that they stop playing as the porter may come in at any time. He said that he stayed in his roomette and made up the beds while [redacted] and [redacted] went to the club car. He went to the club car later and saw [redacted] sitting with a girl. He waited until [redacted] left with the girl and then he went back to his roomette and went to bed in the top bunk. He was reading in his bunk when [redacted] and [redacted] came into the roomette a short time later. He said that [redacted] told him to come down off his bunk and perform an act of felatio on him. He refused and [redacted] told him that he had seen his pers file and knew what he was. [redacted] said that he again refused and lay back in his bunk, pulled the blankets over his head and went to sleep.

7. During the course of this investigation, no other persons were mentioned as being active participants in these acts. In view of this, it is requested that this investigation be concluded by this Detachment.
