1 On 27 May 65, [redacted] - AFP this station, advised the undersigned that [redacted] - 4 CU, had told him of alleged homosexual activities involving airmen.

2 [redacted] had been somewhat vague, but related a story about the Orderly Corporal having found two airmen kissing each other in the lounge part of the Airmen's Club one evening about a month or more previous.

3 In view of this, and the provisions of CAFAG C19-00/17, it was decided to interview [redacted]. He repeated his story more or less as told to [redacted] but specified that he was merely repeating something he had heard among various airmen on the station. The only name he had heard was that of [redacted], who was SOE this station on 26 Apr 65.

4 It was ascertained that [redacted] - AWC/050, had been the Orderly Corporal in question. On interview he flatly refused to submit a written statement, but admitted that he had found two men kissing each other one evening during April 1965. He had not been able to identify them as they had fled from the airmen's lounge when he approached them, but he had discussed the incident among the airmen in the club that evening. No further pertinent information was gained from him.

5 [redacted] - #3 SO, who is the POC of the Airmen's Club was then questioned. He stated that he had heard rumors about this matter, but had received no direct report, and therefore had taken no action. He did say however that [redacted] name as well as the name [redacted] had come to his hearing regarding such activities, but that he had not actually witnessed any unusual displays by these two airmen.

6 There are three airmen on strength at this unit with the names of [redacted], but it could not be ascertained which one is alleged to be involved.

7 No further information could be gained, and despite the fact that information is sketchy, it was reported to the Commanding Officer of the station. He in turn advised the Commanding Officer - ESIU Rockcliffe, under letter C19-00-17(00), dated 4 Jun 65.

8 No further action appears to be warranted by this section, and unless otherwise directed, case is to be considered handed over.
