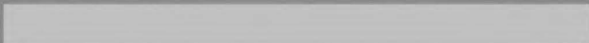

SYNOPSIS

30 Dec 65

Conduct and Discipline  
[redacted] and another

1 At approximately 0030 hrs 23 Dec 65, the writer saw [redacted] at the airman's dining room this unit. It was noted that [redacted] was very unsteady on his feet, and that he smelt strongly of alcohol.

2 The writer escorted [redacted] to room 102 of BA #7, and told him to go to bed. The writer stayed in the barrack block for about 25 minutes, and during this time, [redacted] got out of his bed on three occasions and went to an upstairs room at BA #7. On seeing that [redacted] did not intend to stay in bed, [redacted] who was visiting friends in BA #7, volunteered to look after [redacted] and see that he did not cause trouble. The writer noted that although Baracle had been drinking, he was in full possession of his faculties at this time.

3 At approximately 0030 hrs 23 Dec 65, while occupied with another incident, the writer was approached by [redacted] and [redacted]. At this time, [redacted] reported that [redacted] was causing a disturbance in BA #7, and that the airman present were unable to control him. [redacted] stated that [redacted] had taken [redacted] to room 102 of BA #7, and was looking after him pending the arrival of the writer.

4 Accompanied by the reporting airman, the writer went to room 102 BA #7, and on trying the door found it to be locked. The writer knocked on the door, but received no answer. A master key was then used to unlock the door to the room, and on entering the room the writer saw [redacted] and [redacted] together on a bed. There was no light on in the room, but from the light in the hallway, the writer saw that [redacted] was laying with his head towards the door, and that [redacted] was laying with his head towards the wall away from the door. The subject airman were embracing each other in this reverse position, and the head of each airman was close to the genital area of the other airman. [redacted] was dressed only in a tee shirt, and [redacted] was wearing a tee shirt and underpants.

5 When the subject airman apparently realized that other persons were present, they broke away from their embrace, and [redacted] got off the bed and walked away to the upper floor of BA #7. [redacted] continued to lay on the bed, and did not answer when spoken to by the writer.

6 At the time of the incident, it appeared to the writer that while [redacted] was intoxicated, [redacted] appeared to be sufficiently in possession of his faculties to be aware of the nature of the incident.

7 The incident was reported to the SCD i/c AFF by the writer, and on receipt of this information the SCD i/c AFF ordered the writer to keep casual observation on the subject airman. Checks were made during the night and days hours on the room occupied by [redacted] and no further incidents were revealed.
