Having read and fully understood this warning, I hereby make the following free and voluntary statement:

On 22 Dec 65 I got up at about 0645 hrs and went to work (not positive if I had breakfast or not). After work I came down the hill (not sure if I had supper) changed to civilian clothes and went to the bar. Started to drink (rye & 7 Up) till about 2300 hrs when decided, along with [redacted] and [redacted] to go to the barracks and continue to drink. [redacted] \$4.00 to buy a bottle of rye. Which he proceeded to get somewhere. Went to the barracks and started to drink the rye, along with beer and wine. During our drinking [redacted] proceeded to come in the room at intervals and someone would take him back out. Later on he never came back so we and another Airman went down to check on him. Upon entering the room I sat down on the end of the bed. Then I passed out (not sure if [redacted] had left the room or was still present). When I awoke (by a knocking on the door) believe was grabbing at me. I got up off the bed and went up stairs to the room we were drinking in. Told the other guys I thought he tried to fondle (in a different term) me and was going to go back down and get in a fight. They did not let me. So I had another drink and passed out. Awoke the same morning at 0720 (23) Dec 66) got out of bed went (still had my civilian clothes on) back to the barracks and put my uniform on and went to work.
