MEMORANDUM FOR THE CABINET:

Recommendation of the Cabinet Committee on Security  
and Intelligence

At its meeting on June 27th, 1966, the Cabinet Committee considered a Memorandum prepared by the Security Panel, recommending the establishment of a general inquiry into Canadian security methods and procedures, and proposing terms of reference for the inquiry.
