1. In reference to your minute 2 at flag A you will note from flag C that the concern expressed by the CDS in his memorandum of 5 March has been allayed in part by the advice given by the Deputy Minister of Justice in his opinion at flag B.

2. JAG has taken action through his directive at flag D to advise unit commanders as to the procedures which should be adopted in handling military personnel involved in the activities under consideration following the passage of the amendments to the Criminal Code now before Parliament, and will submit an appropriate amendment to QR&O in due course.

3. Under the circumstances it would appear unnecessary at the present time to take further steps to exempt the regulations for the Canadian forces from the application of the new legislation.
