. During that time, he acknowledged his homosexual orientation and in fact was involved in a gay relationship in that country. He returned to Canada at the end of September and would in the normal course of events be reporting to Winnipeg on October 19 as

Given the current policies of the Canadian Armed Forces, would be a career restricted officer and thus ineligible for promotion and offered no further qualification courses or training. In view of these circumstances and in view of 's health and welfare, I am writing on his behalf to the serious impact on request that he be granted an immediate release from the Forces and from his obligatory service in these compassionate circumstances. I note that according to CFAO 15-7, release in compassionate circumstances is not conditional on financial repayment. Indeed, it would be quite unacceptable to require to make financial repayment when the barriers to his future success as an officer in the Canadian Armed Forces have been erected by the Armed Forces, in its neanderthal policies on homosexuality. Further to this, has no intention of subjecting himself to the interrogation techniques of the SIU.
