DPP Mr. Logan	1. I have manually gone through the filing cabinet reviewed the dates on the 5(d) refusal msgs in the files that are pending. The <u>final</u> answer will be as follows:

a. Since Jan 1988, the following number of service personnel have been retained subject to career restrictions imposed by the interim policy:

1988 - 1 male	1 female
1989 - 1 male	3 female
1990 - 5 male	1 female

b. Since Jan 88, nine personnel have been released for other reasons, after having refused the 5(d) release offer:
