Comments/Remarques

I can now confirm that a meeting has been arranged for you, Eric and I with the Deputy Minister on Friday, May 17th at 2 p.m. I understand that George does not presently have anything scheduled for that time and I am asking him to keep it open.

The Morash discoveries have been confirmed for June 18 and 19 in the offices of Milner, Fenerty in Calgary. As soon as we have confirmed meeting times with the witnesses who are there, I will have Robin contact everyone to co-ordinate travel arrangements. I assume that Rhea, myself, and Gen. Munro will be going.

Finally, I have had to make other arrangements for the afternoon of May 15th. Specifically, I will be working at home, but it will be difficult for me to participate in the Shawver conference call. Do you think that you really need me? I have read her testimony in Weatherall, and I cannot see how she is likely to help us. In fact, her evidence there minimized or trivialized privacy, ie. modesty concerns, and she appears to take a somewhat different view of the concept of privacy from that of Dr. Suedfeld. I will assume that you can proceed without me. Please let me know if you think otherwise, and I can arrange to participate from home.
