CASE SYNOPSIS

BACKGROUND

- 1. As an admitted bisexual who would have homosexual relationships from two to six times a year, was the subject of a Career Review Board (CRB) in Mar 90. At the time, he was serving on a BE, having enrolled . When offered a 5(d) release under the interim homosexual policy, refused, and remained in the CF with career restrictions.
- 2. Although his BE expired 3 Jan 92, was offered and accepted an extension of six months. His present term of service expires 31 Jul 92.
- 3. On , was convicted of two offences under the Criminal Code of Canada, namely pointing a firearm (Section 86(1)(b)), for which he was fined \$500.00, and possession of a restricted weapon (Section 91(2)(b)), for which he was fined \$200.00 and placed on probation for two years.
