APPLICATION FOR REDRESS OF GRIEVANCE

- Refs: A. 5000-12-H TD 8348 (DPLS 3) 18 Mar 93 (Flag AA)
- B. 5000-12-H TD 8348 (DPLS 3) 17 Nov 92 (Flag BB)
- C. 5000-12-H TD 8348 (DPLS 3) 19 Jan 93 (Flag CC)

1. A proposed administrative solution was forwarded to [redacted] at ref B directing that, should she be satisfied with the solution offered, she should return a signed copy to DPLS.
2. When no response was received, a second letter was sent at ref C advising [redacted] that if she did not respond by 26 Feb 93 her redress of grievance would be forwarded to the adjudicative authority, in this case the MND, for a decision.
3. Ref A requests DPCAOR to implement the administrative solution proposed at ref B in light of the fact that DPLS has had no response from [redacted] stating this would be the most "expeditious way to proceed". Ref A further states that following this action the file will be closed and the griever advised of the action taken.
4. Ref C clearly outlined to the griever that if she did not respond, her grievance would be forwarded to the adjudicative authority. It is believed that her lack of response is a clear indication that the griever wishes her grievance to be forwarded to the MND. In any case, [redacted] has every reason to believe that her grievance has been forwarded IAW ref C.
5. It is therefore considered inappropriate to proceed as outlined at ref A and accordingly the file is being returned for preparation of a complete summary to be forwarded to the Minister of National Defence for adjudication.
