In accordance with Section 60(7) of the legislation governing the Canada Pension Plan, consideration has been given to your application for a surviving spouse's pension in respect of the death of [REDACTED]

The legislation stipulates that the surviving spouse is the person of the opposite sex who was residing with the contributor continuously in a conjugal relationship for a period of not less than one (1) year immediately prior to his death.

Information submitted with your application is sufficient to establish that you do not fulfil the above conditions of eligibility. Consequently you cannot be deemed the surviving spouse of the deceased contributor and your application cannot be approved.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you have the right to appeal within ninety (90) days from the receipt of this letter.
