Dear Mr. Drury:

With reference to your letter of January 21st, requesting Treasury Board consideration of a number of cases under Sections 46 B (1) and 46 (6) (iii) of The Defence Service Pension Act, these cases were considered by the Board at its meeting on February 13th, and they have requested further information in connection with Service Pension Board Minute 14331 dealing with the release of [REDACTED] LAW [REDACTED] RCAF and Minute 14333 dealing with the release of [REDACTED] A/Cpl, [REDACTED] RCAF.

The Board are asked to recognize the release of these airwomen as being in the interests of economy and efficiency. From information obtained in investigating these two cases it would appear that they are only two of approximately thirty or more female members of the Royal Canadian Air Force who have been released for alleged unsatisfactory conduct in a particular incident. The Board have noted with some concern the action taken in these cases and have asked me to obtain a full report on the circumstances connected with the incident. They have also asked that because of the serious implications involved in cases of this kind and their effect on the character and reputation of the individuals involved, that you advise the Board as to whether the action taken in these cases has had the approval of your Minister.
