Release

1 The above-noted airman enrolled in the Regular Force on 5 Feb 51. On 22 Jan 53, he was interviewed by a consultant Neuro-Psychiatrist who made a diagnosis of:

(a) Psychopathic personality - sexual pervert
homosexual.

On 10 Feb 53, a Medical Board recommended that he be released with a medical category ApBp.

2 DMS has concurred in the recommendation that this airman be released, but has recommended that he be released as unsuitable with a medical category of A4B. Present policy makes provision for the release of airmen with diagnosis of "Psychopathic personality - homosexual" for "Unsatisfactory Conduct". However, it is considered that to release airmen for "Unsatisfactory Conduct" on the basis of information volunteered to a Medical Officer in confidence would be compromising professional ethics. Therefore, the DMS (Air) recommendation is concurred in and it is recommended that you approve the release of [REDACTED] under the provisions of QR(Air) art 15:01 Item 5 (b) (ii) "Being considered unsuitable for reasons other than misconduct, inefficiency or medical unfitness".
