1 Further to our letter S920-104(SOPA) dated 21 Jan 55, the following additional information is submitted concerning disposal of the a/n airman.

2 This subject was regarded as a suspected case and action was therefore taken in accordance with para 8 of AFHQ letter S370-112TD 188(AMP) dated 11 Aug 53. However, the psychiatrist was not prepared to make a diagnosis of "psychopathic personality - homosexual type" and release action was not possible. The possibility of having the SMO at RCAF Stn Uplands make this diagnosis was considered but he was reluctant to commit himself because of the absense of evidence at the unit and in view of the specialists opinion already given.

3 [REDACTED] was released on 13 Feb 55 at the expiry of his term of engagement. It is recommended that his records be annotated as suspected of having homosexual tendencies to prevent re-enlistment and the appropriate civil authorities advised.
