

Dear Mr. Bryce:

As you are aware, the problems that formed the basis of our memorandum "Homosexuality Within the Federal Government Service" are still with us and we are rather anxious to get the matter cleared up as soon as possible. It is now nearly two months since our last meeting at which time it was suggested that steps would be taken to explore the possibility of setting up an effective research program in co-operation with External Affairs and the R.C.M.P. and that a report should be prepared as a basis for discussion with the Prime Minister and the Minister of Justice on other matters.

2. I would appreciate very much if you could tell me just what progress has been made as from our position as the investigative body, we would like to see some definite policy established in the immediate future.
