Special Constables &
Civilian Members.

Reference is made to the Security Rating Forms now submitted on Civilian Members and Special Constables who are not employed on duties of a classified nature.

2. As such forms are completed on the basis of an indices check only, it is questioned as to whether or not a full field investigation is deemed necessary on all such employees. You will no doubt agree that complete field investigations would reveal certain character weaknesses which normally would not come to light in our indices.

3. Please refer to memorandum dated 16-6-61, to Insp. Barrette wherein the foregoing question was previously under consideration.

THE D.A.O.

In view of the fact that special constables are now classed as regular members of the Force, I strongly recommend institution of a full field investigation as part of the routine engagement procedure, irrespective of whether or not the proposed scope of initial employment will give the individual access to classified material, and suggest that we would be well advised to extend this requirement to include all applicants for employment in the capacity of civilian member.
