Re: Security Screening of Government  
Employees - Character Weaknesses

This has reference to your file [REDACTED]  
report dated 5-12-61, concerning [REDACTED].

2. It has recently come to our attention that J.R. Baxter, Security Officer for the Department of Transport has asked the Secretary of the Security Panel for authority to allow himself or an Officer of the Department to re-interview [REDACTED] on his character defect. The Secretary has granted this authority as he feels that same comes within the Department's terms of Reference.

3. As this procedure, of re-interviewing an employee after he has been interviewed by this Force, may become a practice of this and other Federal Government Departments, it is suggested that this possibility be drawn to the attention of homosexual Government employees during the latter stages of an interview. We can do no more than advise them of this possibility, whether or not they choose to co-operate with the Department is a matter of their own choice.
