Re: Homosexuals Discharged by
the Dept. of National Defence

In conversation with S/L Glen BRIDGEMAN of D.N.D. (Security) on 28 November 1967, BRIDGEMAN informed me that D.N.D. had record of quite a number of homosexuals, both male and female, who had been released from D.N.D. for administrative reasons. In these cases, security enquiries had not been conducted because access to classified information had not been involved. In addition, cases of this nature occurred fairly frequently and there was no indication that the R.C.M.P. were ever informed of the release of these employees.

2. BRIDGEMAN realized that the identity of these individuals, the reason for their discharge etc., could be of considerable assistance to the R.C.M.P. in building up their character weakness indices and possibly as future sources of information in this area of our overall investigation.

3. In view of this BRIDGEMAN volunteered, in future, to keep "A" Branch advised, through periodic memoranda, of the identity of such persons and the circumstances surrounding their release from D.N.D. I thanked S/L BRIDGEMAN for his co-operation and informed him that this information could be used to build up our character weakness indices and as an investigative aid.
