MEMORANDUM FOR MR. WALL:

Re: Character weakness and all that

I think this approach which you and Frazer have worked out is all right in general, although I would suggest that you might delete the word "whole" in the third line of Frazer's memorandum.

As I understand it, we are really aiming at a possible new policy in regard to character weaknesses that expose people to blackmail but the way it has been put I think leads to this conclusion. It also makes me wonder whether we should not have more objective research and analysis of experience in security operations and perhaps even the odd experimental test, or is that going too far with matters that involve emotions and liberties.
