1. During the afternoon of October 14th, 1959 the above named subject was interviewed at our office by Sgt. R.J. ANDREWS and the writer with Mr. J. TIMMERMAN of the Department of External Affairs present. [redacted] at first denied being a homosexual but after some time admitted having engaged in homosexual activities in the past and agreed to assist us by providing the names of others who he knew or suspected of being homosexuals. The following is a summary of the information provided by him.

8. Subject at this point indicated that his homosexual activities commenced when he was in University and have continued on a limited basis over the years. He explained this by saying that although he had occasionally submitted to homosexual acts when he was lonely and drinking heavily, he was actually more heterosexual than homosexual. He stated very adamantly that he did not at any time engage in homosexual activities while posted abroad.

There is nothing to indicate that an attempt was ever made to compromise subject during his period abroad.

19. While reading through the External Affairs Register [redacted] also came to his mind as being a homosexual. The information is very indefinite as is the identification [redacted] Subject recalled that he was [redacted] An effort will be made to further identify this individual. [redacted]

24. Subject was re-interviewed by Sgt. ANDREWS and the writer on October 16th, 1959 but the only additional information he could offer was that as outlined in paragraph 15 of this report.

25. Subject has agreed to give this matter further thought and will contact either Mr. TIMMERMAN or this office should he recall anything of value to us.
