Security Risks Arising Through Human Weakness

I attach a letter from the Commissioner of the R.C.M. Police which arrived while you were away, together with a report entitled "Homosexuality Within the Federal Government Service" which is to be considered by a small committee of the Security Panel. There are a number of things about the paper which I find disturbing, but I would prefer not to comment on it until you have had the opportunity to study it.

I have already sent a copy of the report and its covering letter to Norman Robertson and have discussed it briefly with Paul Pelletier. I have not, however, sent a copy to Mr. Hughes as yet, as I was not sure that you had been able to speak to him about this matter prior to your leaving.
