

MEMORANDUM FOR MR. BRYCE

Discussions with Dr. F.R. Wake Concerning
Security Risks Arising Through Homosexuality

I attach an interim report which Dr. Wake has prepared after consultation with Mr. Frazer and myself concerning methods which might be adopted to deal with the problem of homosexuality in the public service as it affects the national security. I should like to discuss this matter with you in conjunction with the report which has been prepared by the R.C.M. Police, as you may consider it useful to put Dr. Wake's views before the committee of the Security Panel which will presumably be discussing the Police paper fairly soon.
