MEMORANDUM FOR MR. DALL:

I thought I should put on record that the Prime Minister this afternoon agreed with your suggestion the Department of National Health and Welfare might employ Dr. Wake on the special study in connection with security as you suggested.

I told him that Dr. Wake was a psychiatrist and had already been consulted on a professional basis on this problem and therefore this did not involve spreading the knowledge of our interest in it.

Note to File

It has been agreed among PEO, Cameron and Steele that Dr. Wake will be paid about \$420 a month for 12 months, plus necessary travel, to study the problem of homosexuality as it affects security. Most of the study will be in the U.S., at universities as well as at NSA and CIA. Starnes) XA will arrange the latter two visits, which have been approved by W.A. Robertson.
