This has reference to the recent interview of [REDACTED] which was conducted by your investigators in Section A3 on September 26, 1961 - your file [REDACTED].

2. We realize that to obtain worthwhile information in this particular field it is necessary to interview persons whom we suspect are afflicted with this particular character weakness. However, in this particular case, we do not feel that a sufficient amount of information was available on [REDACTED] to warrant an interview at this time.

3. In the future we would suggest that interviews only be conducted with those persons on whom a sufficient amount of information is available. While this would not altogether preclude the possibility of an unsuccessful interview, we feel that in this way our chances for achieving a successful interview would be greatly enhanced.
