## Homosexuals asking equal job treatment

in The Globe and Mail on Tuesday that investigations of Tuesday that investigations of prospective officers focus on "character weaknesses," such as homosexuality. The force wants exemption from a proposed new law giving federal employees access to their own personnel files, the spokesman said man said.

ing of Mounties or in RCMP security clearances of other federal employees.

"If this attitude prevails in the hiring of its own officers, how many security clearances and, therefore, promotions and jobs does the RCMP deny gay people?" his letter to Mr. Fox asked.

Mr. Fox's office said it was too soon to say if the request for a meeting would be granted.
