SUBJECT Security Screening - Reliability Factors

Your footnote of 83-11-18 forwarding your memorandum of the same date to the D.O.P. refers.

The original SSOM 72 was forwarded to the Minister for his information. The Minister raised some concerns as a result of which the bulletin was amended. A copy of the amended bulletin is attached.

It is noted that present plans are to have the content of Bulletin SSOM 72 published as part of Ops. Manual II.8 after the latter is considered and approved. As you know, the draft of Ops. Manual II.8 has been transferred to "A" Ops. for review.

I have now determined that it will be some time before the review of Ops. Manual II.8 is finalized. I feel, therefore, that Bulletin SSOM 72 should not be withheld until Ops. Manual II.8 is published. I am sure you will agree that Bulletin SSOM 72 represents an important policy change and should be made available to Force personnel in the interim. In view of this, it is recommended that Bulletin SSOM 72 be published as an Ops. Manual bulletin without delay.
