

Your memorandum of 85-07-22 refers.

While I had personally provided my views during the CO/DSRR Conference, I have since taken the opportunity to solicit the opinions of the membership at large in "L" Division. This has, without exception, resulted in an immediate and specific rejection of the suggestion that individuals with these tendencies could be employed in any capacity within our current police enforcement and societal profile.

I can, therefore, unequivocally state that the opinions as contained in the Commissioner's "Aide Memoire" are indeed a reflection of the opinion of the members of the Force in this Division.

One other area of concern which arose during our discussions on this matter was the medical implications for anyone who might, as a consequence of their employment, have to work in close proximity to an individual whom it has been proven is more suspectible to the contracting of highly infectious diseases such as AIDS. Indeed, a somewhat related manifestation of this has been recent concerns raised by our CPR Instructors regarding the use of training dummies and the potential for contraction of AIDS through the presence of saliva.
