As far as I am aware DG; Cha his mandate to be the CF, and no attention is being paid to our civilian employees.

- Presuming the CF maintain their current policy we can expect our military members and civilian employees to have quite different conditions for sexual orientation, age, marital status, and disability. This is bound to cause friction between the two.
- Most of our civilian concerns are common to the Public Service at large. However, if we wish to impose conditions on our civilian employees because of similar conditions imposed on our military members, then we have a major project. My recommendation would be to have DCAA appointed to the Charter Issues WG, or whatever it is called as the member and advisor responsible for civilian issues.
