

Attached is the most recent draft of the proposed circular on the above subject. Its purpose was to provide additional information to that contained in the Code of Conflict as a guidance to employees and managers, especially at missions abroad. While the information contained in the proposed circular is useful, it does on occasion duplicate (in some cases in the same words, with or without quotation marks) what is in the Code of Conduct and Conflict of Interest Guidelines and the Discipline booklet and Chapter Six "Personnel Security" of the Manual of Security Instructions. It would be counter-productive to issue yet another document dealing with essentially the same subject. In our view it would be preferable to expand the Code of Conduct and/or Discipline booklets to contain any additional information that would be useful to circulate. In a few instances, such as the section on Rotationality, the most appropriate home might be the section on this subject in the Manual of Procedures (to be incorporated into the Personnel Manual).
