Attached is a copy of the draft Memorandum to Cabinet, Ministerial Recommendations and detailed recommendations for amendments to the Canadian Human Rights Act.

Justice has indicated that they have endeavoured to balance the concerns expressed by departments and by 50-60 private sector groups that they met with in June and present an approach that is moderate yet meets many of those concerns.

Could you please forward your branch or division's comments directly to Lise Thérour (11th floor, Vanier Building) by September 16, 2:00 p.m. She will then prepare a synthesis of the views expressed and circulate it for your feedback and potential revisions before the document is sent to Justice on September 26.

In light of Justice's deadline, I would appreciate that everyone endeavours to respect the following timeframe:

- September 16, 2:00 p.m. - Feedback to Lise Thérour
- September 18, 4:30 p.m. - Synthesis circulated to branches and divisions
- September 22, 10:00 a.m. - Feedback to Lise Thérour
- September 23 - Revisions and discussions with parties involved, if required
- September 24 - Document sent to Mr. Kingsley for his approval
- September 25 - Document sent to the Secretary for his approval
- September 26 - Document sent to Justice
