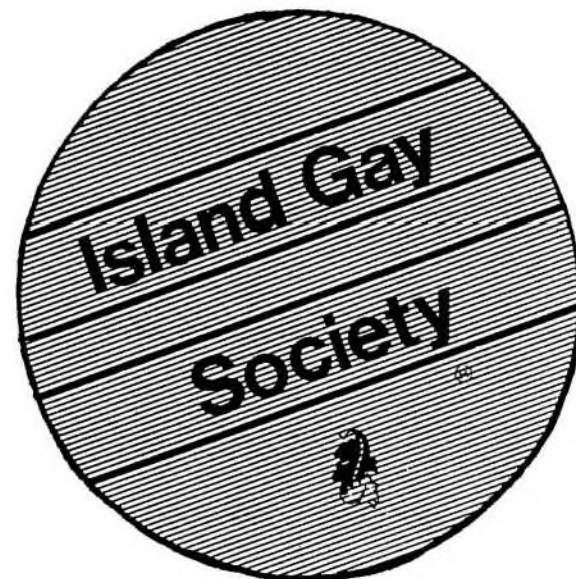

The Island Gay Society is an organization committed to fostering supportive environments wherein economic and cultural barriers can be overcome and the goal of human equality realized. To these ends we engage in educational, cultural and social activities as a means of dealing with the sexism, ageism, homophobia and heterosexism in our communities and in our lives.

The name Island Gay Society was chosen for the boldness of its public statement. It was not meant, however, to limit participation to gay and lesbian persons only. All people are welcome, and encouraged to join and enrich the organization through their membership, input and participation. The IGS encompasses a wide range of open-minded people, both gay and straight.

PURPOSE

The IGS is a gay support organization dedicated to combatting prejudice in general and homophobia in particular in both the gay community and the community-at-large.

To this end, the IGS offers a wide variety of services to the community:

PERSONAL SERVICES:

- Lay counselling.
- Medical and legal referrals.
- Speakers for non-gay-oriented groups.

EDUCATIONAL/CULTURAL:

- Inviting guests to address, instruct, and educate.
- Attending and conducting workshops.
- Actively sponsoring activities within and between branches of the IGS.
- Supporting local, provincial, national, and international organizations and groups working on behalf of gays and lesbians.
- The IGS is a member of the International Gay Association.

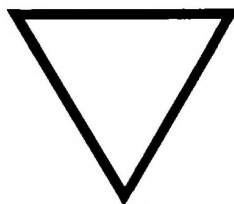
SOCIAL:
