One female member of this Division indicated her intentions to cohabitate with another woman. Your office was contacted by phone and the decision was made that the member would have to submit a letter of cohabitation and forward security documents to this office for a security update with regard to the other person.

I am sure that sooner or later a male member will be applying to cohabitate with another male and I would appreciate your rationale on the subject of members cohabitating with a person of the same sex so that my personnel follow the proper procedure for security clearances. Any assistance you can give me on this subject would help clarify the situation.
