ADVISORY NOTE

It was intended that the survey would be administered to a stratified random sample representative of the composition of the Canadian Forces. However, an error was made in the computer program used to generate the sample and, consequently, the sample was flawed.

In view of the error in the sample selection, the results reported in this document should be interpreted with caution. The use of inferential statistics, particularly as reported in Chapters 4, 5 and 6, should be disregarded.

The programming error which led to the flawed sample was entirely the responsibility of the Department of National Defence. The enclosed survey report has been treated as a draft and further work has been suspended on it because of the flawed sample.
